Denise Tan is a Singaporean cellist, currently pursuing a Masters of Music in Performance at the Trinity Laban, where she has been awarded the Alan Niekirk Scholarship. She is studying with Prof Derek Aviss OBE. Denise completed her undergraduate studies at the Yong Siew Toh Conservatory of Music, graduating with a Bachelor of Music (Honours) in Cello Performance, under Mr Leslie Tan.

Passionate about traditional music, she was a member of the Singapore National Youth Chinese Orchestra from 2016 to 2019, holding the position of principal cellist from 2018. During her time with the orchestra, she participated in international concert tours and festivals, such as the Macau International Youth Music Festival and the 36th Shanghai Spring International Music Festival.

Denise has been involved in the Singapore local scene, playing both Western classical and Chinese traditional music. Ensembles she has worked with include the Musicians' Initiative, Metropolitan Festival Orchestra, Asian Cultural Symphony Orchestra, Ding Yi Music Company and The Philharmonic Orchestra.
