Longfield Hall is located 15 minutes from Loughborough Junction station and Brixton, Stockwell and Oval tube as well as local bus routes.



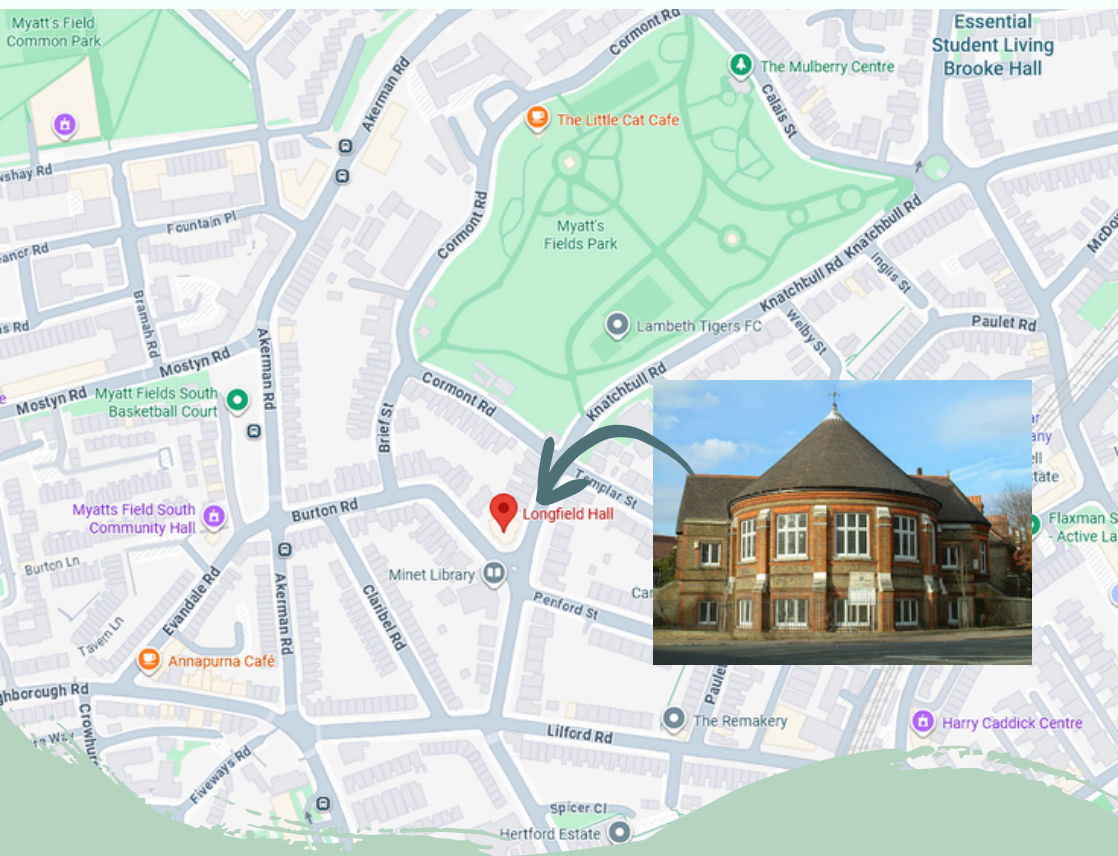
